Pacheco and printed with green and orange, currently laid on a piece of buff card and with some marks and pen numbered 1 to top right corner with two punch holes, the reverse in brown and having Cancelled in pencil to centre, overall good (2) £400-600
- Argentina, an 1888 specimen 1000 pesos banknote, marked for the Republica Argentina El Banco National, Serie 001, the single sided note with some marks and two punched holes, small chips to edges, some staining, and having pen numbered 39 to top right corner £300-500

- Bolivia, a late 19th century proof print of a 5 Boliviano note, the engraved print in brown and with portrait of a young lady marked Banco Nacional De Bolivia, laid on a large piece of card, some marks and dirt but overall good and some marks to card £50-100
- Bolivia, two late 19th century proof prints, one an Un (one) Boliviano partial print in green and orange, the other two fragments in two colour variations of a Cinco (five) Boliviano stuck on a piece of paper, both As Found £50-100

- Bulgaria, a c1919 printer's test print specimen of a 1000 Leva Zlatni bank note, with front and bank on roughly cut paper, marked in pencil with initials and dated 25/11/19, lots of wear and marks, the reverse marked Bradbury Wilkinson & Co Ltd London, with pencil marks and also an ink partial finger print to lower right, damaged to upper right, appears to have been circulated in 1920 £200-300
- Bulgaria, a c1919 printer's test print specimen of a 1000 Leva Zlatni bank note, with front and bank on roughly cut paper, some wear and marks but overall good, the reverse marked Bradbury Wilkinson & Co Ltd London. This note appears to have been circulated in 1920 £200-300
- (Republica de) Costa Rica, an 1871 specimen 2 (Dos) Pesos bank note, single sided in black with red to centre, stamped SPECIMEN in red and two punched holes, some staining and marks and some creasing £1,000-2,000
- (Republica de) Costa Rica, an 1865 specimen 1 (Un) Peso bank note, single sided in black with green to centre, stamped in red SPECIMEN and two punched holes, some staining and marks and minor creasing £1,000-2,000
- Crete & Credit Lyonnais, c1900, two lithographic printer's test prints, one for a 100 Drachma, laid on paper with the reverse having three test prints of a Credit Lyonnais (Madrid) cheques, marked in pencil Last Proofs July 19th, together with a test for a 10 Drachma partial note, rough cut with damages (2) £100-200
- Cyprus, a single piece of paper with hand drawn and watercolour painted essay for a one pound note, dated 1960, paper creased and grubby and some pencil writing to top right, folded to centre **£200-300**
- Egypt, possibly, a lithographic printer's test reverse in blue and orange laid on cut and torn paper with pencil writing marked "Nate" and "Egypt", some marks and staining £50-100
- Greece, a 1940s printer's test of a single sided and single coloured 500 Drachma note, with hand written date of 19.8.46, and typed "Plate colour Sp Green Light." to lower left, some marks and minor creasing £200-300
- Greece, A c1920s specimen or test print of the reverse of a 500 Drachma bank note in black, single sided, small tears and damage to left margin, some creasing and marks £200-300
- Greece, a 1940s specimen or printer's test of a single sided and single coloured reverse for the 10,000 Drachma note, in orange, some creasing and marks but otherwise good. This note appears to have been circulated in 1945, but there are some very small and subtle changes notably the writing in the upper frieze was shrunk and this appears to be for the 1947 second release £200-300
- Greece, A late 1930s lithographic test print in single colour on one side for the reverse of a 1000 Drachma note, with Athena on left and view of Acropolis to centre and watermark window to right, with typed writing "Plate colours 29 & 30." and pencil "& Black" to lower left, small fold to left corner, some minor creasing and marks, but otherwise good. This note appears to have been made in 1939 and released in 1940. £200-300
- Greece, A late 1930s lithographic test print in single colour on one side for part of the obverse of the 1000 Drachma note, with script to centre and portrait of a traditional Greek lady, dated 1941, with two signatures, also with typewritten statements "Plate Colours border 43.7 & Black" and "Portrait Spec. Brown 7 43 & black.", overall good just some minor marks and creasing. Please see previous lot as this could be the obverse for the 1939 note

This note was circulated in 1972 but was note printed in green. Overall very good condition, some minor creasing with some minor marks and staining

- Malaya, three rare 1940s lithographic printer's tests single sided and single coloured prints for the obverse and reverse of the ten thousand dollar bank note, marked for the Board of Commissioners of Currency Malaya, the front with two prints, one in tan brown (with typewritten "Brown 14." and the other in green(with typewritten "Malaya \$10,000" and "Green 38." and "3.6.44", the back with typewritten "Green 38.", overall good but some marks and stains, the brown print with tear and fold to upper left corner and some creases to all three (3) £2,000-3,000
- Malaya, three rare 1940s lithographic printer's tests single sided and single coloured prints for the obverse and reverse of the one thousand dollar bank note, marked for the Board of Commissioners of Currency Malaya, the front with two prints, one black (with typewritten "Black." and the other in purple (with typewritten "Malaya \$1000" and "Violet 4.." and "3.6.44.", the back with typewritten "Back Violet 4.", overall good but some marks and stains, creases to all three (3)

The specimen for this note had a blue section to the centre and had numbers and perforated specimen mark £1,000-2,000
- Malta, The Anglo-Egyptian Banking Company Limited, a very rare possible pre-specimen printer's test print of a ten pound note, dated 1st Oct. 1886 from Malta, with portrait of the Grand Master Jean Parisot de Valette to left and marked Bradbury Wilkinson & Co Engravers & c London, with no numbers of signatures, quite a lot of marks and staining and creasing and lower left corner torn off and damaged. The specimen for this note had a green section to the centre and had numbers and perforated specimen mark £500-1,200
- Malta, The Anglo-Egyptian Banking Company Limited, a very rare possible pre-specimen printer's test print of a five pound note, dated 1st Oct. 1886 from Malta, with portrait of the Grand Master Jean Parisot de Valette to left and marked Bradbury Wilkinson & Co Engravers & c London, with no numbers of signatures, heavily stained to right hand side and creased and damage to lower margin and left corner and top right corner, other marks an creasing. The specimen for this note had a brown section to the centre and had numbers and perforated specimen mark £300-500



- Malta, The Anglo-Egyptian Banking Company Limited, a very rare possible pre-specimen printer's test print of a one pound note, dated 1st Oct. 1886 from Malta, with vacant portrait cartouche, with no numbers of signatures, heavily stained and damaged to lower section with other marks an creasing. The specimen for this note had a brown section to the centre and had numbers and perforated specimen mark £100-200
- Malta, The Anglo-Egyptian Banking Company Limited, a very rare possible pre-specimen printer's test print of ten shilling note, dated 1st Oct. 1886 from Malta, with portrait of the Grand Master Jean Parisot de Valette to left and marked Bradbury Wilkinson & Co Engravers & c London, with no numbers of signatures, heavily stained to left hand side and some creasing and with other marks, also some pencil marks with some on margins from where it was cut out. The specimen for this note had a brown section to the centre and had numbers and perforated specimen mark £200-300
- Mexico, El Banco De Jalisco, a rare 19th century possible pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 1000 Pesos bank note, single sided in black ink, with cartouche to each side, one with lady holding cane and the other with cherub with a torch and key, marked Bradbury Wilkinson Y Ca Grabadores Londres to lower centre, with vacant No areas and only dated 18, with lots of marks and stains, folded top right corner and top left corner damaged and chipped lower left £300-500
- Mexico, El Banco De Jalisco, a rare 19th century possible pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 500 Pesos bank note, single sided in black ink, with cartouche to each side, one with cherub mining with an axe and the other with a locomotive train, marked Bradbury Wilkinson Y Ca Grabadores Londres to lower centre, with vacant No areas and signatures, and only dated 18___, with lots of marks and stains, folded top left corner £300-500
- Mexico, El Banco De Jalisco, a rare 19th century possible pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 100 Pesos bank note, single sided in black ink, with cartouche to each side, one with bust of Britannia and the other with oxen and hay cart, marked Bradbury Wilkinson Y Ca Grabadores Londres to lower centre, with vacant No areas and signatures, and only dated 18__, with lots of marks and stains £300-500
- Mexico, El Banco De Jalisco, a rare 19th century possible pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 50 Pesos bank note, single sided in black ink, with cartouche to each side, one with head of a lady and the other with the head of a horse, marked Bradbury Wilkinson Y Ca Grabadores Londres to lower centre, with vacant No areas and signatures, and only dated 18__, with lots of marks and stains and chipped to corners and torn to upper margin near centre £150-250
- Mexico, El Banco De Jalisco, a rare 19th century possible pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 1 Peso bank note, single sided in black ink, with three cartouches, one with head of a dog, the centre with classical head of Bacchant and the other with the head of a ram, marked Bradbury Wilkinson Y Ca Grabadores Londres to lower centre, with vacant No areas and signatures, and only dated 18___, with lots of marks and stains and one corner chipped £200-300
- Mexico, El Banco De Londres Mexico Y Sud America, a rare 19th century possible pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 500 Pesos bank note, single sided in black and red ink, with two cartouches, one with head of a gentleman and the other of Mercury seated attaching the wings to his feet, with Mexican eagle with snake to centre, marked Bradbury Wilkinson & Co Engravers London to lower centre, with Serie A and vacant number areas and signatures, and only dated 18__, slightly misshapen when cut, with lots of marks and stains £500-1,000
- Mexico, El Banco De Londres Mexico Y Sud America, a rare 19th century possible pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 100 Pesos bank note, single sided in black and yellow ink, with two cartouches, one with head of a gentleman and the other with three cherubs, Mexican eagle with snake to centre, marked Bradbury Wilkinson & Co Engravers London to lower centre, with Serie B and vacant number areas and having signatures, and only dated 18__, with For The London Bank of Mexico & South America Limited, slightly misshapen when cut, with lots of marks and stains, notable crease and damage to left side margin £500-1,000



- Mexico, El Banco De Londres Mexico Y Sud America, a rare 19th century possible pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 50 Pesos bank note, single sided in black and orange ink, with two cartouches, one with head of a gentleman and the other with cherub in a boat, Mexican eagle with snake to centre, marked Bradbury Wilkinson & Co Engravers London to lower centre, with Serie and vacant number areas and having signatures, and only dated 18__, with For The London Bank of Mexico & South America Limited, slightly misshapen when cut, with lots of marks and stains and notable pencil marks £500-1,000
- Mexico, El Banco De Londres Mexico Y Sud America, a rare 19th century possible pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 10 Pesos bank note, single sided in black and brown ink, with two cartouches, one with head of a gentleman and the other with Bacchant, Mexican eagle with snake to centre, marked Bradbury Wilkinson & Co Engravers London to lower centre, with Serie E and vacant number areas and having signatures, and only dated 18__, with For The London Bank of Mexico & South America Limited, slightly misshapen when cut, sadly quite heavily stained, with lots of marks notably top left corner with damage £300-500
- Mexico, El Banco De Londres Mexico Y Sud America, a rare 19th century possible pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 5 Pesos bank note, single sided in black and green ink, with two cartouches, one with head of a gentleman and the other with head of a bull, Mexican eagle with snake to centre, marked Bradbury Wilkinson & Co Engravers London to lower centre, with Serie F and vacant number areas and having signatures, and only dated 18__, with For The London Bank of Mexico & South America Limited, slightly misshapen when cut, sadly quite heavily stained, with lots of marks and top left corner damaged £300-500
- Nepal, a c1990s photograph of a design for a Nepalese 20 Rupee bank note, this note appears to have gone in to circulation in 1992, some minor marks £30-50
- Philippines, a possibly 1940s hand drawn and painted essay design for a 100 Pesos bank note, the card panel with portrait of Antonio Luna (Filipino Army General) on left side with pencil work, this model was probably part of a tender to get the production but it appears the work went to TDLR. the board measures 28cm by 19cm with further pencil notes to top right hand corner, some marks and staining and various smudges and pencil marks £100-200
- Portugal (Banco De Portugal), an early 20th century, c1910, printer's proof litho print of a (10) Dez Mil Reis bank note, in three colours, with pencil notes to lower section, appears to have been stuck down at some point as some damages to corners and roughly cut, some marks and staining £100-200
- El Salvador, Deuda Publica Del Salvador, a late 19th century pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 500 (Quinientos) Pesos bank note, single sided in black ink, with cartouche of Mercury to left and 500 to right, with blank spaces for numbers and signatures and marked San Salvador but undated with 18__, with Bradbury Wilkinson Y Ca Grabadores Londres, probably c1870s, it appears to have once been stuck on to another piece of paper as there is damages to the margins and traces of glue to reverse, there is a lot of marks and some staining £300-500
- Figure 2015 El Salvador, Deuda Publica Del Salvador, a late 19th century pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 100 (Cien) Pesos bank note, single sided in black ink, with cartouche of Mercury to left and 100 to right, with blank spaces for numbers and signatures and marked San Salvador but undated with 18__, with Bradbury Wilkinson Y Ca Grabadores Londres, probably c1870s, it appears to have once been stuck on to another piece of paper as there is damages to the margins and traces of glue to reverse, there is a lot of marks and some staining £300-500
- El Salvador, Deuda Publica Del Salvador, a late 19th century pre-specimen printer's proof or test print of a 50 (Veintecinco) Pesos bank note, single sided in black ink, with cartouche of Mercury to left and 50 to right, with blank spaces for numbers and signatures and marked San Salvador but undated with 18__, with Bradbury Wilkinson Y Ca Grabadores Londres, probably c1870s, overall fair to good, it appears to have once been stuck on to another piece of paper, traces of glue to reverse, there is a lot of marks and some staining £300-500
